

2009 Preview Changes

- 🐾 Entry fee has been increased to \$35 per entry and \$70 for a late entry because of rising costs
- 🐾 You will need to bring a wheelbarrow or some way to transport manure from the stalls to a manure spreader which will be located at the end of the barn (the tubs that had been placed near the stalls in the past will not be available).
- 🐾 You cannot place manure anywhere except in the new container.
- 🐾 Late entry fees must now be postmarked by May 22nd (entries will no longer be accepted until June 1st).
- 🐾 Exhibitors will be permitted to nominate judges as cattle are checked in. If you wish to nominate a judge, be prepared to follow this procedure:
 - Index cards will be available at check-in
 - You may nominate one judge per exhibitor for the junior show
 - You may nominate one judge per exhibitor for the open show
 - Nominations will be placed in a box for each show at check-in
 - You should be prepared to include the judge's name, a contact number for the judge and your name on the nomination form
 - Nominations will not be accepted after cattle are checked in

Exhibitor's Meeting

There will be an exhibitor's meeting on **Friday after the junior show**. At this meeting important decisions concerning the 2010 Preview will be discussed. The Kentucky Angus Association lost over \$7,000 on the 2008 Preview; we simply cannot sustain any more losses like this. Topics of discussion will include, but will not be limited to, ways to offset the rising cost of the Preview, entry fees, alternate locations, awards, payment of judges, etc. The Board of Directors needs the input of ALL exhibitors before making a decision concerning the 2010 Preview. Please make plans to attend. It is, after all, your show, and the Officers and Directors are very open to considering any and all ideas from the membership.
