

GUIDELINES FOR THE KENTUCKY ANGUS PREVIEW SHOW AND THE KENTUCKY JUNIOR ANGUS SHOW

1. All exhibitors must be members of the Kentucky Angus Association or the Kentucky Junior Angus Association.
2. Junior exhibitors must be eligible under the National Junior Angus Association Guidelines (contact Glenn & Pam Bugg with questions).
3. All animals must be in exhibitor's name by May 15th.
4. All cattle must be registered in name of Kentucky member with a Kentucky address on the papers.
5. Entries postmarked by May 15th are \$35 per head. Entries postmarked **after** May 15th and **on** May 22nd are **\$70 per head (entries may not appear in catalog)**. **No entries will be accepted after May 22nd**. Entry fees will not be returned after May 22nd. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry or cattle will not be allowed to show.
6. Calves born in current year can only be shown if first shown in a cow/calf class.
7. All animals must have a readable tattoo corresponding to the registration certificate. Exhibitors must bring original registration certificates to the show.
8. All animals must have current health papers as required by the KY Department of Agriculture.
9. After cattle are checked in, class breakdown will be determined using the futurity system.
10. Stall space will be assigned by the show committee and must be adhered to by all exhibitors.
11. Exhibitors should keep area around exhibit clean and place manure in designated area.
12. Appropriate rules concerning fitting, confirmation, breed eligibility, etc., of the American Angus Association apply to all entries.
13. National Junior Show rules will be adhered to concerning the Junior Preview Bull Show.
14. **---Exhibitors will follow the same fitting guidelines as the American Angus Association.**
15. **All rules are strictly enforced.** The decisions of the committee are final.
